2022-2023 funding,

We received a total of 12 applications totaling request of \$971,500.00 for this year, our 2022-2023 grant budget allows for \$600,000.00 we tapped our reserves which allowed us to increase our budget to help award funding. Although, few applicants received full funding, there isn't one of those 12 applications and their reason/request for funds that isn't needed and justifiable, and we appreciate their hard work and dedication to help ensure services and programs to the individuals in Montgomery County. We asked all applicants who receive 708 funds to engage with other recipients to reduce duplication of services and to enter into working arrangements with the others to help ensure that our tax dollars are being used wisely and share ideas to help keep others informed of what is being done locally. We have a duty to the taxpayers of Montgomery County to provide funding for projects and programs statutorily within the guild-lines of the State of Illinois Community Mental Health Act (405 ILCS20/), which pertains to Developmental Disabilities (DD), Substance Use (SU) and Mental Health (MH). Each year it becomes a harder task to stay within the budget, we are constantly looking at revisiting our application process to help stay informed of the needs of Montgomery County.
