Teens and parents will sign up for six (6) sessions that are designed to point out some of the problems the teens could be headed for and help come up with ways to avoid them.

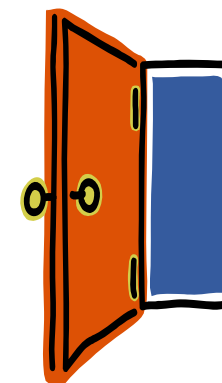


The members of the group will go on trips, watch videos, and talk with people who have already made these same choices.
